North Country Dairy Farmer Blake Gendebien, Democrat for NY-21, Raises More Than \$380,000 in the Fourth Quarter of 2025

Gendebien enters 2026 with more than \$2 million cash-on-hand, totaling more than \$4.4 million raised

Lisbon, NY – Today, dairy farmer and small business owner Blake Gendebien announced his campaign to represent New York’s 21st Congressional District has raised **more than \$380,000** in the fourth quarter of 2025. The haul is a testament to the grassroots enthusiasm behind Gendebien’s campaign, with more than **69,000 unique donors** chipping in an **average contribution of \$36**.

Gendebien has connected with voters across the North Country at more than 100 community events, including 15 town halls in every county in the district. As a farmer and employer, he’s focused on tackling corruption and ineffectiveness in Washington to lower costs, strengthen rural healthcare, keep communities safe, and put the North Country first.

“Our campaign leads this primary with a decisive, six-to-one fundraising edge because Mr. Gendebien is cutting through the noise and building the coalition and resources needed to win this November,” said **Campaign Manager Michael Waller**. “Across the North Country, voters want common-sense leadership in Congress, and they know Mr. Gendebien is the only candidate who can win this race and deliver.”
